TEEC Commands Center—will stand at 1330 today

- Strike zones Corpus Christi to Freeport with land fall late Friday or early Saturday
- Evacuations are already getting underway with counties that felt they should be evacuating
- Hurricane force wind band will extend far and will be a big problem
- Rainfall will be large with surges expected up to 10 feet in strike zone—will be large
- San Antonio--Main shelter hub, this is where the patients evacuating will be triaged
- Trying to set up shelter in Austin not really certain if this will work due to the potential for difficulties in Austin---suggestion that we bring patients further north, though we know that San Antonio will be overflowed with patients
- Already at H-48, actually beyond that
- Expected that medical special needs evacuations will be completed tonight with some follow-up of
- Presidential declaration is done
- We have volunteers for command center set, Geli states will send the list out.
- Becky SMS asked if the focus of these calls is the outpatients, Geli responded that the Network is also tracking the acute patients.
- Some confusion with 211 patients receiving incorrect information regarding the registration of patients with 211, the registry will shut down tonight.
- Decision made to just have a call at 1230 tomorrow and Geli will update us this after noon with information form the 1630 call via e-mail
